



FOREIGN LANGUAGES PLACEMENT TEST* SCORES

Students eligible to take the foreign language placement tests are those who have not yet taken a foreign language class in college. Students must take the course they place into and pass it with a C or better in order to get credit for lower courses in the sequence. The sequence of courses that can be tested out of are: 1010 (Elementary 1), 1020 (Elementary 2); 2010 (Intermediate 1), 2020 (Intermediate 2). Please advise students to retain their score sheet and bring it to the Foreign Languages & Literatures department secretary once grades are posted in order to get the credit. Credit is not automatically posted.

NOTE: 1010 does not count toward a language major or minor, but carries credit toward the student's 120 hour graduation minimum.

FRENCH

170-240 Place out of 1010 into 1020
241-290 Place out of 1010 & 1020 into 2010
291-360 Place out of 1010, 1020 & 2010 into 2020
Anything over 360 Refer student to Department Chair

GERMAN

170-240 Place out of 1010 into 1020
241-290 Place out of 1010 & 1020 into 2010
291-360 Place out of 1010, 1020 & 2010 into 2020
Anything over 360 Refer student to Department Chair

SPANISH

170-240 Place out of 1010 into 1020
241-280 Place out of 1010 & 1020 into 2010
281-350 Place out of 1010, 1020 & 2010 into 2020
Anything over 350 Refer student to Department Chair

This set of placement scales applies to the new Windows version of placement tests from Brigham Young University, which was adopted in our department on 04/26/2005 and modified on 09/06/2007. For placement test results before 4/26/2005, please use the old placement scales.

*This is **not** a CLEP test, it is the departmental placement test. The Foreign Languages & Literatures department at MTSU does not accept CLEP scores for placement.
